Walk to End Lupus Now - Milwaukee

May 11, 2019

This is the LFA, WI Chapter's flagship event, held at Hoyt Park in Wauwatosa, WI. It was emceed by WISN-12's Sheldon Dutes (whose grandmother suffered from lupus). Seven hundred and forty two lupus patients and their supporters walked this 1- or 2-mile route on Milwaukee County's Oak Leaf Trail, participated in a bucket raffle, and enjoyed a light snack and entertainment following the walk. This year we included a tent for our presenting sponsor, GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) and their Us in Lupus initiative. A nurseeducator interacted with patients & attendees & handed out lupus educational materials.

Milwaukee Milkmen Nonprofit of the Game

June 27, 2019

The LFA, WI Chapter was this new team's first Nonprofit of the Game in their new stadium in Franklin, WI. Volunteers sold tennis balls to fans for a post-game ball toss and worked in the concession stands. A lupus patient threw out the first pitch, and volunteer and Board Chair Sarah Oberhofer gave a short interview about lupus itself and the Foundation from the pitcher's mound prior to the start of the game. LFA, WI Chapter received 100% of the proceeds from the ball sales and a portion of the total concession proceeds from the game.

Madison Mallard's Community Charity Night

The LFA, WI Chapter staff sold game tickets in a designated section prior to the game. On game day, a group of LFA, WI Chapter staff and volunteers sold 50/50 raffle tickets from our tent at the entrance to the park and in the stands throughout the game.
